But in the developing countries, it is reaching alarming proportions where people's lifestyles are changing such as tobacco use, higher consumption of fatty foods and reduced physical activity. Tobacco use is the single largest preventable cause of cancer in the world.

- Limit Alcoholic consumption
- Quit Smoking
- Regular Health Checkups

VT Seva Cancer Outreach Program

- Pilot Cancer screening program launched in Oct 2007, in Warangal Dist., AP, India
- Conducting door-to-door campaign by educating rural people about cancer and how to reduce their chances of developing it
- Free Screening to detect early cancers
- Free outreach program in rural areas, every 2 weeks, using a Mobile Diagnostic Lab with X-Ray, Ultrasound & Mammogram equipment and a team of 5 doctors, 10 technicians and 30 social workers
- Over 1700 people examined of which 150 people tested positive; in last 3 months, indicating the importance of screening
- Thanks to NRI Hospital Guntur for lending their Mobile Lab for VT's outreach program. Other best area hospitals are also generously providing free further medical tests & treatments

But there is much more to be done ... there is a dire need to have many such programs in hundreds of other districts, and reach out all those rural people who otherwise would not have medical care and hope!
